

4 Ways to Use LiveSafe During Protests and Large Gatherings

1

Broadcast Messages

Send broadcast messages to your community to keep them informed.

Use Case: Send a broadcast message via text, email, or the LiveSafe Mobile App to notify users of nearby road closures as a result of the protest or large gathering.

2

Report Incidents

Submit reports of safety and security incidents due to the protest.

Use Case: User reports an incident of possible theft and property damage of several cars with broken windows near the protests and includes pictures of the vehicles.

3

Report Suspicious Activity

Submit reports of suspicious behavior due to the protest.

Use Case: User anonymously reports suspicious backpack left under a bench at the large gathering and chats with security in real-time to help them locate the abandoned bag.

4

Geofence

Create geofences around specific locations to communicate with specific groups.

Use Case: A geofence is created around the location of the protests to ensure all important protest-related broadcast messages are sent to users near the protests.
